SUBJECT: 2010/2011 Wood Badge Scholarship Program

Enclosed you will find information on the 2010/2011 Wood Badge Scholarship program, designed especially for VFW members who participate in scouting.

Three National scholarships will be provided for each of the four Scout Regions. The scholarship provides the course fee up to \$150.00 for the seven to eight day training program. The recipient must provide transportation to and from the course training location.

Wood Badge for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century – a single, more contemporary training program for Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Varsity Scout, Venturing, Council, District leaders and professionals – replaces both the Boy Scout Leader Wood Badge and Cub Scout Trainer Wood Badge programs.

This course offers more emphasis on leadership and "people" skills, less focus on Scout craft or Cub Scout training skills. Skills developed from the new Wood Badge training will help a volunteer leader do a better job in any BSA program at any level of involvement.

The application should be completed in accordance with the instructions thereon and must be postmarked no later than April 1 to: Veterans of Foreign Wars National Headquarters, Attn: Steve Van Buskirk, Director, VFW Programs, Suite 902, 406 W. 34<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City, MO 64111

Qualified current members of your Post, who are active in Scouting, should be encouraged to apply for the Wood Badge Training scholarship. If additional applications are needed, contact this office.
